

# At His Feet, In His Service: The Mary and Martha Journey



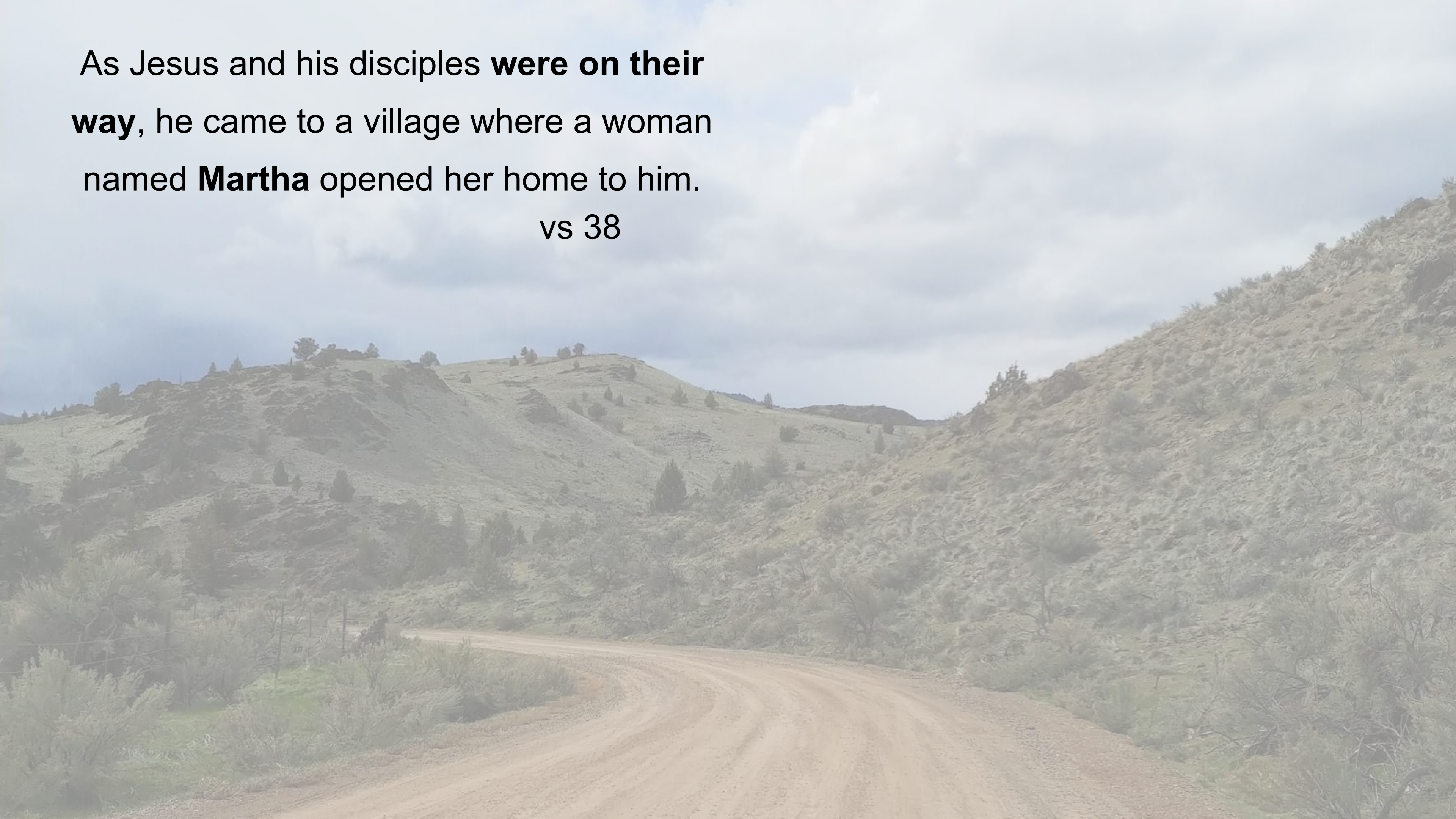
